1. Introductions and apologies

Introductions and apologies were made.

2. National Grid / Cadent gas mains work and PRS build (including traffic management)

DJ provided an update on the current works and the road closure on HPR. The road closure on Mary Neuner Road is operational and in its early stages. **JM** was concerned about vehicles turning right on Hornsey Park Road and highlighted that it is becoming a more frequent issue. **IR** also raised concerns with lorries and other large vehicles doing U turns in the ERS driveway. **JM** further asks how the road closure signage will stay up. **DJ** stressed that the area is fenced off and all access will come from Clarendon Road. Also, there is a dedicated person to check all the traffic signage is visible and clear. **DJ** will also look into putting some cones up around the bend of MNR.

DJ said the 6 week programme for the pipework is on track and is a delicate and careful process. The AGI pipework is complete and they are now planning the venting of the old pipework. **DJ** highlighted that this may be a noisy procedure and that he is looking to carry this out during the day. **Local Dialogue** will liaise with **DJ** to send out flyers and letters to alert local residents of the noise and will post a paragraph on the website to alert residents of the noise.

DJ advised that venting of the old pipework will commence on the W/c 4th Feb, but this would be subject to good weather conditions and other factors. **Local Dialogue** will remain in contact with **DJ** over this date. **JM** also provided news of another half road closure on Western Road, due to the re-plumbing of Alexandra Primary School.

Action: Local Dialogue to update residents as soon as these plans are confirmed.

3. St William update

RB provided the St William update. National Grid have agreed a deal in principle to sell Phase 2 of the site in March. After this, National Grid's involvement in the site will be largely complete. **JM** raises the issue about the fencing and the security risk the damaged fence brings. **ND** stressed that National Grid have consulted their land ownership department, and they have been advised that the fence is not in National Grid's land holding. St William have liaised with the Haringey Council about who the fence belongs to as it is believed to be the owner of the land which is currently leased to Iceland.

4. Communications update and RBLG in 2019

RB asked whether the e-mail updates about the works are informative. **JM** said more information could be added and they are not as helpful as talking face-to-face. **RB** advised that the next RBLG will take place on the 25 March 2019. This will be the final RBLG National Grid representatives will attend and the meeting will be chaired by St William.

5. Capital & Regional update

SD said that they had a good footfall for Christmas and that some retailers were asking for more space. The mural on Martin's Walk was also going well.

The next meeting is scheduled to take place on **Monday 25th March 2019**.
