1. Introductions and apologies

Introductions and apologies were made.

2. Cadent gas mains work and PRS build

PD confirmed that the PRS building is almost complete and that the majority of civil works have been completed.

PD also confirmed that they will be installing the pre-cast elements around the PRS in early/mid July and hope to have a completion date of 24 July.

3. St William update

MR confirmed that concrete pouring has commenced and they are on course to finish Block C1 by December 2020. A tower crane will be erected for the A blocks, and this crane will go up in June.

MR also confirmed that the information centre will be complete in two weeks.

JM confirmed that a new fence has been erected at the back of Iceland's car park, following **MR's** discussion with the Council.

JM asks if the crane lights can be turned off during the night. **MR** to investigate.

4. Communications update

RB confirmed that this is the final RBLG National Grid will be involved in and chair. **RB** said that handover of communication history etc will take place to St William in the coming months.

MR confirmed that St William would be happy to continue attending if still arranged by the PRMA / other stakeholders but would like to set up separate construction-focused meetings with local residents and stakeholders as its work continues on site. St William is also meeting local residents on 9 April.

RB confirmed that National Grid will continue to provide email updates and answer hotline calls etc until site works on complete in July 2019.

JM asked who will take over the Haringey Heartlands website. **RB** said this is to be confirmed depending upon the authorities required etc but the site was due to run until December 2019 currently.
