Part One – National Grid update

1. Introductions and apologies

Introductions and apologies were made.

2. Traffic Management Update

There was a brief discussion about the traffic management plan. It was mentioned the plan has now ceased with the closing down of SI work on site. **JM** said he had no issues to report.

3. Air, dust, noise, vibration and asbestos monitoring

JM said that residents near the southern area of the site had complained about levels of vibration affecting their properties.

PH responded that monitoring data showed vibration levels had been within industry standards.

KJ requested monitoring data to be collected for the southern area of the site.

JM asked if calls could be made to residents if and when high levels of noise are expected.

MB said Local Dialogue could liaise with **DT** in order to anticipate when high levels of noise may be expected to inform the residents.

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DT said he would provide dates and times of site activity that may create vibration and noise.

There was a discussion about a complaint from a resident who claimed cracks on the structure of their property have worsened and vibration from the site was the cause. It was mentioned that in National Grid's response the resident was referred to the project website which shows monitoring data to be within industry standards.

4. tRiIO works on Mary Neuner Road and timeframe for mobilisation onsite

DT gave an update on tRiIO works on Mary Neuner Road and their programme for full mobilisation on site. He said there have been no changes since the last meeting in September. **DT** said that they might remain on site until March or April providing there are no issues or delays.

IR asked whether work would be done by May because the vehicular movements may have an impact on the Local Elections on 3rd May.

DT said it is possible they may be on site up until the Local Elections but agreed to update and inform stakeholders accordingly.

MB said that Local Dialogue would ensure that all stakeholders are informed should there be any risk that work goes on up to the election period.

DT added that Mike Eyres will be the project manager for the PRS and will be able to provide a lot more detail at future RBLG meetings on tRiIO's work.

4. Communications Update

There was discussion relating back to what had been mentioned earlier in the meeting with complaints from residents regarding vibration, and agreement that monitoring would be carried out in the southern corner of the site. It was also reaffirmed that Local Dialogue would endeavour to inform residents by phone of activity that may lead to vibration and noise.

MB said that of the resident surveys that have been returned so far they were overwhelmingly positive, complimentary of the RBLG and the level of engagement and communication that has been pursued by the project team. **MB** emphasised that there were mentions of vibration and that some residents said they did not understand the overall goals of the project.

JM agreed that residents had difficulty differentiating between the National Grid and St Williams' objectives, and that there was obscurity around what the end result of the project would look like.

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There was discussion about the gardens on Hornsey Park Road affected by Japanese Knotweed and in particular Roger Kemp and his contact with Cllr Mann. **MB** said that we have received no further communication from Cllr Mann.

MB confirmed that the project website has been updated with data and details of the next phase of the project, and that an update letter has been sent to residents informing them about tRIIO mobilisation onsite.

6. AOB

There was no other business discussed.
